

**Banmirra Arts Inc will be running a Possum Skin Cloak Healing Workshop for Aboriginal communities of the Hunter region to share their possum cloak, discuss cloak protocols, make a baby cloak for each group and for children to make possum skin armbands**

***Possum skin cloaks are one of our most sacred artefacts as Aboriginal people. Banmirra Arts artists, Vicki Couzens, Maree Clarke & Lee Darroch are leading the revival of cloak-making across South-eastern Australia. They ask you to come to share the three cloaks you have made, record the meanings, discuss protocols, to make a baby's cloak and armbands for children.***
