Applications for scholarships of up to \$10,000 per annum are invited from Aboriginal people who are currently undertaking, or who intend to undertake post school studies/education/research in a culturally related course commencing in 2017. Culturally related courses may include but is not limited to the following:

Post school studies/education/research may include University, TAFE, Traineeship/Apprenticeship or other Vocational Education and Training with a Registered Training Organisation.

This position is open to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people only in accordance with Section 14(d) of the Anti-Discrimination Act 1977. An Aboriginal person (As defined by the Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983) means:

- Is a member of the Aboriginal race of Australia, and
- Identifies as an Aboriginal person, and
- Is accepted by the Aboriginal community as an Aboriginal person.

Preference will be given to applicants who live or have a connection with the Upper Hunter region of NSW. Scholarships may be awarded for up to three years depending on duration of course and maintaining eligibility for the scholarship.
